



Bayou Segnette Cypress Planting Volunteer Today to Restore Coastal Louisiana

The Coalition to Restore Coastal Louisiana, Jefferson Parish and Entergy Corporation invite you to participate in a cypress restoration project along Bayou Segnette in Jefferson Parish, Louisiana. The objective of the project is to increase habitat quality and promote a healthy cypress forest along the Bayou Segnette Waterway. The restored cypress forest will provide critical habitat for wildlife and provide storm protection to adjacent marsh and camp sites.

This project is being completed through a partnership with Jefferson Parish, Coalition to Restore Coastal Louisiana, Entergy Corporation, National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, Restore America's Estuaries, Barataria-Terrebonne National Estuary Program, National Association of Counties Research Foundation, Shaw Coastal and Coca-Cola. Volunteers will plant over 3,000 pots of bald cypress over 2 days.
