



Coastal Restoration Coordinator Job Opening

The Coalition to Restore Coastal Louisiana (CRCL) is looking for a passionate, motivated and organized individual to oversee the Coalition's Community-Based Restoration Program. From dune restoration on the Cameron shoreline to marsh plantings in Terrebonne Parish to cypress forest restoration on the north shore of Lake Pontchartrain, CRCL's Community-Based Restoration Program is a multi-year program which partners with local, state and federal agencies, landowners, corporations, and other organizations to utilize volunteer labor for on-the-ground restoration projects across the coast.

CRCL is seeking a Coastal Restoration Coordinator to plan and implement multiple on-going coastal restoration projects. The Coastal Restoration Coordinator manages all aspects of the program including selection of project sites, grant management, volunteer coordination, budget oversight, and general project management. The Coastal Restoration Coordinator must be an innovative and outgoing team player able to work with numerous partners, federal and state agencies and volunteers. The Coastal Restoration Coordinator must have some knowledge of natural coastal systems and project planning.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of bachelor's degree, preferably in an ecological field or environmental engineering field, and/or three years experience in coastal restoration, project management and grant writing
- Experience in project management, including developing proposals, managing budgets and reporting
- Experience with planning and/or implementing a restoration event, preferably a volunteer event
- Excellent social and interpersonal skills, speaking and writing ability
- Must be detail oriented and able to manage time appropriately
- Must be willing to work weekends at restoration events
- Ability to operate a towing vehicle, boat, 4-wheeler and/or other field equipment is a plus
